The Clerk was instructed to Hotify Hon. Maury Maverick, Chief, Governmental Requirements Branch, War Production Board that this Board would attend a meeting of County Commissioners from all Coast States to be held in Washington, D.C. at 10.00 A.M. March, 9th & 10th 1942.

Due to attendance at the above meeting the Board postponed the next regular meeting from March 10th to Wednesday March, 11th.

Judge Miles and Judge Wible of the Orphans Court asked the Board to have a telephone installed in the Orphans Court room.

The Board appointed Mattingly Johnson, Harvey Hilton, Hem Pennison and Lange assessors for the new assessment to be held this year.
