Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

C. Henry Camalier, States Atty, Requested the Board to approve the transfer of Carlyle Traynor, charged with rape, to either the Marlboro or Baltimore City jail for safe keeping. The Board decided to leave the matter to the judgment of the Sheriff, he ~~having~~ having the authority to transfer ~~him~~ the ~~prisoner~~ if, in his judgment, the transfer is justified.

The Board authorized the Clerk to refund \$45.11 to Howard Lawrence, 2nd Dist. for double assessment on land for the years of 1938-1939-1940-1941. The County Corporation of Maryland having paid taxes on the same land during the above years.

The Board discussed the State Tax Commission's certification of the stock of the 1st National Bank of St. Mary's at a valuation of \$7773, for the purpose of taxation, and decided that such a low valuation was entirely unjustified, and would practically wipe out the Banks tax on its shares. The Board instructed its Atty., Senator Philip H. Dorsey, Jr., to take the matter up with the State Tax Commission and try to have the valuation on the Banks shares increased to a reasonable sum.

On the certificates of Dr. L. B. Johnson and Dr. F. F. Greenwell the Board committed Joseph Grover Ching to Spring Grove State Hospital, as of July, 30, 1942, with the understanding that he would be transferred to ~~in~~ a Veteran Hospital as soon as possible, and would not remain a charge against the County.

On the certificates of Dr. P. J. Bean and Dr. F. F. Greenwell the Board ^{Patient} committed Benj. L. Joy to Spring Grove State Hospital as of Aug, 17, 1942. ^{and not go}
