Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

C. Henry Camalier, States Atty. and State Officer Jackson, appeared before the Board and stated that they had been urged by the State and Federal authorities to ask the Board to provide a Camera for photographing Criminals in St. Mary's County. The Clerk was instructed to try to obtain a prior wity rating for the purchase of a camera, as soon as Officer Jackson had provided the necessary data, including price.

Mr. W. Vincent McDougal, Project planner for the Federal Public Housing Authority appeared before the Board and informed It of a proposed defense housing groupe of 150 houses to be located at Jarboesville, 8th Dist.for use of the civilian workers at the Naval Air Station, when the Station is put in operation. He said the Federal Authorities would take astrip of land on the west side of the Three Notch road from Jarboesville to Hermanville, about 57 acres, for these houses. Mr. McDougal asked that the Jaboesville end of the County road running to Trailors store be relocated, and that the Board approve the building project. Mr. McDougal was asked whether the property would be taxable, and whether proper arrangments for sanitation would bemade, also whether any provision would be made for the increased school facilities that would probably be needed, and whether the property owners were satisfied with what they were offered for their property. After calling the Washington office by phone, Mr McDougal stated that the County would be reimbursed for loss of taxes, at least for the duration of the war, but he was unprepared to answer the other questions. The Board tobk no action at this time.

Mr. Ike Weiner requested the Board to appoint Jack Kremer a Constable for the 8th Dist. Mr. Weiner offering to pay the cost of bond and to pay the Constable's salary. No action taken by the Board.

Messrs G.E. Thomas, Chas Henderson, Joe Henderson and Clint Henderson reported to the Board that the public road running from the end of the State road on St. George Island to apublic landing on the St. George river which had been in continuous use by the public for more than forty years had now been closed by Mr Frank Klimkiewicz. The Clerk was instructed to write Mr. Klimkiewicz and direct him to remove the barrier from this road.

Mrs Mary S. Hayden and Mr. and Mrs Ed. Hodges requested the Board to accept into the County road system, for maintenance, an extension of the Canoe Neck road, about .2 mile, 7th Dist. Mr Thompson asked to report and to contact Mrs Hayden.

Letter from Mr. Wm.S.Donaldson about the condition of the Bethel Church road,4th Dist., referred to Mr.Thompson for his attention.
