Baldwin, Architect and The War Public Works Authority, Richmond, Va. in reference to the County's request for funds for a new jail, and inform them that due to the terrible conditions existing from overcrowding in the old jail, making it impossible to keep old jail sanitary and free from vermin, the County is now without a jailor, without any present prospects of obtaining one and that the newly elected Sheriff, after viewing conditions at the jail has written the Governor and resigned ~~the office~~ before he took the oath of office.

The newly elected County Commissioners having qualified the Board turned the affairs of the County over to them and adjourned sine die at 10.55 A.M.
