The Federal Authorities of the F.W.A. in Richmond, Va. were contacted by telephone and they suggested a plank for the County to raise \$\$\frac{2}{3}\frac{1}{3}\text{x000}\text{xand} \$75000.00 and the F.W.A. would contribute \$56700, making a total of \$131700.00 which their engineers had figured would be necessary to complete the plans that had been submitted by the County; or as an alternative plan the F.W.A might contribute the whole amount and the Government take title to the necessary land and carry out the project ax

with the Federal Government owning the project.

The Clerk was instructed to write Mr. Kenneth Markwell, Regional Director, F.W.A., Richmond, Va. that the County was unable to contribute any amount for the building of a jail etc. That no bonds could be sold, and that as the need for anew jail etc was caused entirely by Federal war work in the County the Federal Government should provide the money for this project.

That, if necessary, title to the land could be passed to the Government and it could own the new jail(It being understood that the County would operate it ), and also to ask that the matter be treated as an emergency measure.
