Minutes of preceding regular meeting and special meeting of March, 30 th read and approved.

Col. Barrett, Judge France, Mr. A. F. King and Mr. B. I. Smith, appeared before the Board and asked that the County provide 6 large and 20 small air whistles and a two-way radio for air raid signals in the County, the air whistles to be operated ~~garages~~ at Garages having air compressors and suitably located to give the County the maximum coverage possible.

Mr. Smith stated that the recent request by the Fire Departments for new and rebuilt sirens need not be granted if these air whistles were provided. The Board took the matter under advisement.

The Committee of Oystermen interested in having Millers Wharf, 1st Dist, made a public landing, again appeared before the Board and urged that the site be condemned. The Board ~~decided~~ that ~~the~~ before ~~the~~ deciding on any course of action they would go down and look the situation over, and set next Tuesday, April, 20th as the time for doing so.

Miss L. M. Dent, Superintendent of Public Schools, appeared before the Board and asked that some provision be made for the County to pay the teachers a bonus in addition to the \$200.00 to be paid by the State. No action taken by the Board.

The Board fixed the salary of the the Clerk at \$1800.00 per year, to be effective as of June, 1, 1943, when the new law concerning Clerks salary becomes effective. The Board stipulated however that any fees that might be payable to the Clerk should be discontinued.

The Board granted the Supervisor of Assessments an additional \$100.00 per year for expenses, making a total of \$300.00 per year for his expenses.
