The Board decided that it would consult Congressman Sasscer on Thursday April, 29,1943 in regard to their application to F.W.A. for Federal Funds for a new jail and temporary Jailors Quarters.

The Clerk was instructed to write the State Dept. of Public Welfare and recommend the appointment of Mr. Harry M. Jones to the St. Mary's County Welfare Board in place of Daniel J. Bowles, resigned.

The Board decided to allow the Mechanicsville Auxillary Fire Dept.a sum not to exceed \$75.00 for the purchase of two air whistles for alarm purposes; but that on any other eqipment that might be needed in the County it would require that the cost of the equipment be stated before it would authorize its purchase.

The Board authorized the publication of the 1943 levy in the Enterprise and Beacon.

Capt.Matt Bailey asked the Board to accept into the County road system for Maintenance the short section of road from the and of the State Road to the Water in front of his store. Mr. Bailey was informed that if he would give the County a right-of-way deed the Commissioners would recommend its acceptance.

Mrs Wm.A.Lantz asked the Board to have a culvert installed at her entrance on the St.Andrew's California road at its intersection with the Three Notch road. She also presented awritten request that when the grading is done for widening the Three Notch road material be dumped in the old roadbed left when the Three Notch road was straightened in oder to fill in the depression. Title to the old road bed kaxing abutting her proper having reverted to her when it was abandoned for public use. Received from:

The Board discussed with the State roads COmmission the local bill which provides for servicing the County road bonds from the County's share of the gasoline tax.

The State Roads Commission put up strong objection to this bill becomming a law, and offered as an alternative proposition; that if the County Commissioners would agree to request the Governor to veto this bill the Commission would allocate \$10,000.00 per year from the County's share of the gasoline tax which could be applied to debt service.
