Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Dr. Eugene C. Peck and Mr Kirkman discussed with the Board the question of the appointment of a County Health Officer and also the question of the County providing for a laboratory for St. Mary's Hospital.

The Board reaffirmed the action of the County Commissioners on March, 17, 1942: which agreed that the County would provide ~~next~~ not to exceed \$550.00 for equipment, and \$450 per year as part of a technician's salary and a reasonable sum per year for supplies for a laboratory at St. Mary's Hospital.

The Board recessed and immediately convened as the St. Mary's ^{County} Board of Health and reappointed Dr. Eugene C. Peck County Health Officer for a term of four years from May, 1, 1943.

The Board of Health adjourned and the County Commissioners resumed their meeting.

The Board ordered the publication in three news papers of the Trailer law and also a notice that the law would be put into effect June, 1, 1943 and all penalties provided by the law for violations would be strictly enforced. the Board also ordered that 500 posters summarizing the law, and also having the notice, be printed and that poster be stuck up at prominent places in the County. the board also ordered that suitable license forms be printed and that licenses be made available to any who wished them on and after May, 24, 1943.

The Board also ordered the State wide "Work or Fight " law be published in three Papers and notice given that it will be strictly enforced and that posters for this law also be printed and put up in prominent places. throughout the County.

The Board ordered that the position Balff & Assistant Clerk to the Trial Magistrate Court and Inspector of Weights & Measures be discontinued as of May, 15, 1943 and that Mr J. Aubrey Norris, Baliff & Assist. Clerk and G.A. Hebb, Insp. of Wts & Meas. be paid in full to above date and notified in writing that; due to the necessity of curtailing County expenses where ever possible it found this action necessary.
