The Board executed the necessary papers and authorized its Attorney to file a demurer to the suit of certain Trailer Owners, in the Circuit Court, for an injunction against the Commissioners to restrain them from enforcing the Trailer License Law.

At 3.05 P.M. the Board of Education arrived and the two Boards immediately convened in joint session to further consider the question of transporting children to schools not receiving State aid.

Information from the State Superintendent of Public Schools, which was desired, before taking any final decision in the matter, not being available the consideration of the transportation question was postponed until the next regular meeting, July, 27, 1943.

The Joint session of The Board of Education and the County Commissioners adjourned at 3.20 P.M.

The County Commissioners immediately resumed their regular meeting. The question of maintenance of County roads and the labor supply for same was discussed. Mr.M.C.Thompson, in charge of the maintenance of County roads, being out of Town and not available for consultation, no action was taken by the Board.
