Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Mr. John F. Bean, Contractor for transporting children to Little Flower school, 2nd District, appeared before the Board and stated that the public School bus had carrying capacity sufficient for certain children attending Little Flower school and requested the Board to issue an order directing the Board of education to transport these children to and from school. Mr. Bean was advised to get the names of the children concerned and present them to the Board together with the particular Public School bus that would be affected and the Board would take the necessary action.

On motion of Mr. Jarboe, seconded by Mr. Guy and declared carried, the Board fixed the salaries of all Justices of the Peace of St. Mary's County at \$100.00 per year, to start with the year beginning May, 1, 1943.

Miss L.M. Dent, Superintendent of Public Schools, again appeared before the Board and requested it to provide the funds for the purchase of certain land adjacent to the Great Mills High School. The Board discussed the matter with Miss Dent but took no official action.

The Board authorized the employment of Miss Mary Wilkinson, as assistant to the Clerk, for general work in the County Commissioners office.

On the certificates of Dr Eugene C. Peck and Dr Frank A. Camalier the Board committed Teresa Ruth Combs to Rosewood State Training school.
