Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Rev. S.J. Rudtke, S.J. appeared before the Board and stated that he had purchased a used school bus in New York for \$1500.00 and requested the County to take this bus off his hands. The County to own the bus and he to use it for the transportation of school children. Father Rudtke was informed that there were no funds available for this purpose at this time.

Commissioner Jarboe informed the Board that he had been invited by Mr. Jas J. Baldwin and Mr. Wm. A. Loker to go with them to Richmond, Va. and had accepted the invitation, and that while there the Office of the F.W.A. had informed him that they would retain Mr. Jas. J. Baldwin as Architect to supervise the construction of the new Jail; but that in the case of the new Great Mills High School the project involving more than \$100,000.00 they were obliged to turn it over to the F.P.H.A. in Washington and lacked authority to designate the Architect to supervise the construction. Mr. Jarboe informed the Board that he had requested Congressman Sasser's office to take the matter up with the F.P.H.A. and make an effort to have the school project turned back to the F.W.A. in Richmond, but up to this time he had no word as to whether Congressman Sasser had been able to accomplish this. Mr. Jarboe also reported that the F.W.A. were much concerned over the question of a right-of-way to the new jail and authorized him to say that if the Key Estate would grant the right-of-way through their entrance to Tudor Hall they would grade the hill at the entrance and pave the roadway from the street to the East boundary of the Court House grounds, and that he had interviewed Dr. Sothoron Key, as directed by the Board at its last meeting, in reference to the Estate deeding a right-of-way to the County and also selling to the County a strip of additional land adjoining the Court House grounds, and that Dr. Key had stated that he expected to be in the County some time this week and would stop in this office and talk the matter over.
