Minutes of preceeding meeting read and approved.

Mr. Stephen Bojanaski, Federal Public Housing representative at Lexington Park and Mr. John Klapp asked that the road from Jarboesville to Trailers Store on #5 highway be repaired. Mr. Bojanaski stated he would furnish some trucks to help with the job. Mr. Thompson was present and stated that he would attend to the repairs as soon as possible, and that if he could get Mr. Houghton to load the trucks he could get the part near Lexington Park repaired at once.

Mr. Bojanaski also asked the Board to adopt certain regulations for Lexington Park. He was told to put the desired regulations in writing and they would be submitted to the Attorney to the Board and if approved by him

would be taken up again at a later meeting.

Mrs. Lorena F. Burch of the Welfare Board, appeared before the Board and explained that the State Dept. of Welfare had directed that starting the first day of January, 1944, the Welfare Board would have to increase the amount allowed for food, under the various categories, by a considerable amount, but she had gotten the Dept. to allow her to work out the increase at a smaller amount than the State had demanded, and she asked for the

The Board agreed to allow the amount asked each month.

The amounts needed for the next fiscal year to be submitted by the Welfare Board at a later date.

The Clerk was instructed to write State Roads Commission and ask for waiver of certain physical requirements in the case of Cecil Russell and Geo. H. Cullins, County Road workers.

Sheriff Howard V. Hammett asked the Board to increase the salary of the Jailor. The salary of \$10.00 per month being fixed by law, the Board referred the matter to its attorney to decide if anything can be done. The FWA having demanded a right-of-way to the new fail, and asked for parking space, the Board decided it would have to start Condemnation proceedings, the owners of adjacent land having refused to sell.

Board granted an allowance of \$500.00 a year for expenses to the Supervisor of Assessments.

The Clerk was instructed to write the State Roads Commission and recommend that certain physical requirements for road works be valved in the case of Cecil Russell and Geo. H. Cullins.

The Clerk was instructed to write the State Roads Commission and recommend the following county roads for oiling this year:

4th & 5th districts: For oiling, the Thompson Corner Budds Creek road 12miles; Mechanicsville to Chaptico 4 miles. 7th district: Abells to Avenue, 2.25 miles.

3rd district: Sunnyside school to Loveville, 4 miles; Compton to St. Clements Shore, 1.5; Beavue to Britton Beach, 2.5 miles. 6th district: Bonds neck road, 1.5 miles; Clarks Landing, 1.2 mbles. 8th district: California toward Patuxant Beach, 1.3 miles; Horsehead

road, 3.5 miles. 2nd district: West toward Valley Lee, 2.5 miles; McKay's Beach 1.5; Tall Timbers, 1 mile.

1st district: St. Inigoes to Beachville, 3.miles; St. Inigoes to Dameron 2 miles.
