Dent, comprising a delegation representing the County School Teachers, appeared before the Board and asked that some provision be made to provide a bonus for teachers of \$200.00 per year and that this be kept up for one year after the war. There was considerable discussion of the matter. The delegation was advised that the Board would consider their request and take the question up again at a later date. Mr. W.E. Tobin and Mr. John H.T. Briscoe, comprising a committee of the Taxpayers association, asked the Board to allow this committee, including Mr. William G. Fenwick, to sit with the Board when the tax levy is made up. The Board agreed to this. 6n motion of Mr. Jarboe duly seconded and declared carried, the Board agreed to provide this committee with a list giving the salaries paid all officials for the calendar year of 1943 and to be paid them in the calendar year of 1944. Mr. Wood inquired why work had not been started on the County road from #5 Highway near State Roads Garage to 3 Notch road. Mr. Wood was told that Mr. Thompson had been asked to repair this road.
