Board met at 10:15 A.M.

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Mrs. Chas. Fenwick presented a letter from the St. Mary's County Teachers Association urging the Board to provide certain sums for Teachers bonus. Miss L. M. Dent, Superintendent of Schools, also presented a copy of resolutions adopted by the Board of Education urging the County Commissioners to make provisions for paying teachers bonus. Miss Dent felt that the payment of \$140.00 per teacher, between now and Jan. 1st,1945, would satisfy the County's obligation under both the law of 1943 and the law of 1944 and would make the County eligible for a refund from the State of \$27.00 per teacher, making the net cost of the bonus to the County \$113.00 per teacher. The Board agreed to give the request its attention.

Mr. Howard Evans appeared before the Board in reference to the lend the preceding Board had agreed to sell him from the Alms House farm. The record showed that the old Board had agreed to sell him one half acre at \$50.00 per acre, and that Mr. Evans had paid \$25.00 for this land. Mr. Evans now claims the Board later agreed to let him enlarge this lot to one and one quarter acres. The Board decided that it would give Mr. Evans a deed for one and one quarter acres upon payment of the balance of \$37.50.

The Board signed a deed for three acres of land from the Alms House farm to Leonard C. Spalding, which had previously been paid for.

Mr. Chas. J. Mattingly, Sanitary Inspector, complained to the Board about the condition of the toilets at the Leonardtown public school. Mr. Mattingly said new toilets would have to be provided for this school, and that the Commissioners of Leonardtown would not permit the installation of any new outside toilets in the Corporation limits. Miss Dent was present and was asked to find out what it would cost to install inside toilets and connect them with the town sewer system.

Mrs. Boney Wood heading a delegation again complained about the condition of the Maypole road, 3rd District. Mr. Thompson was present and promised to make some repairs to this road at once.

Mr. Thompson also requested to finish the Bushwood-Dynard road, Ath District, as soon as possible, and to repair the Cornfield Harbor road, 1st District, Mr. Thompson thought it would be about six weeks before he could do anything to this road.

Mr. Jas. J. Baldwin appeared before the Board in reference to remodeling of the Great Mills High School. Mr. Baldwin was informed that the Board of Education held title to the school and were the proper ones to see in the matter.
