Board met at 10:15 A.M.

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Miss L.M.Dent, Supt. of Schools, and Mr. P.J. Bailey appeared before the Board in reference to purchasing about 13 acres of additional land adjoining the Great Mills High School lot. The Board decided that in the event that the Board of Education did not receive a sufficient amount from the F.P.H.A. In lieu of taxes on Lexington Park and other F.P.H.A. projects to enable it to purchase this land, this Board would provide funds to make up the difference. The amount to be provided not to exceed \$1,300.00 in any event.

Mrs. Lorena F. Burch, acting Executive Secretary S t. Mary's County Welfare Board, appeared before the Board and explained that it Was impossible to obtain burial for deceased 6.A.R. recipyients for \$50.00 and asked the Board to allow her to retain \$100.00 from a balance in the 0.A.R. fund which was to be turned back to this Board and that the State would match this with \$200.00 which would enable them to pay \$75.00 for burial. The Board agreed to this plan.

Messrs. Jno. H.T. Briscoe and Wm. Tobin appeared before the Board in reference to title to the new jail. It was explained to them that this Board had made a special trip to Richmond, Va., to try and find a satisfactory plan whereby the County could retain title to both land and building. But the F.W.A. officials demanded 50% participation in cost and it was deemed inadvisable to do this and the Board had therefore agreed to condemnation of the land by the Federal Government and the construction of the jail as Federal owned project. The Board agreed to pay a fee of \$25.00 for legal work in connection with each tax sale and the ratification of same; provided the work was done with reasonable promptness.

On the certificates of Dr. F.F.Greenwell and Dr. Frank A. Camalier, the Board committed C.Adrian Goldsborough to Spring Grove State Hospital as of June 14, 1944.

The Board executed a lease with the F.W.A. for the new jail.
