Minutes of prededing meeting read and approved.

Bailey, Atty. to Board of Education, appeared before the Board and again requested this Board to provide \$5,260.00 to take care of a deficit in schools funds due to the State's refusal to allow State funds to be used to pay teachers where the school had failed to make a certain average attendance. It was explained to Miss Dent and Mr. Bailey that the Board had no funds, that were not already pledged for other purposed.
