A delegation comprising Mesdames J.E. Bietzell, Larry Owens, Chas. Huseman, Arthur Lawrence, Webster Owens, Francis Mattingly and Miss Maggie Tate, of the Seventh District urged the Board to widen, resurface and oil sections of roads:-

1. Cabbage Alley Road
2. Marsh Point Road

Mr. Thompson of State Roads Commission was present. The Commissioners favored the projects, but it was pointed out that resurfacing and oiling are scheduled in advance and that the allocation of oil and the movement of equipment cause delays. The delegation was promised maintenance immediately and the desired improvement as soon as it can be arranged. Mr. Jarboe moved that the Wehrheim Road (4 miles) be added to the oiling schedule and completed as soon as possible. Board approved. Clerk was directed to inform Mr. Thompson of the action.

Mr. Nace Wathen appeared and requested that road from his place to Morganza be repaired. Mr. Thompson to be notified.

Delegation comprising Rev. Bro. Martian C.F.X., Mr. R.B. Broun Jr., and Mr. Stewart Bennett requested that work begin on the County Road from Highway #5 toward Foxwell's Landing be resurfaced and oiled. It was stated that Mr. Webb and Mr. Cheeney had been talked to about this project and that they advised that an early application be made for same. Matter referred to Mr. Thompson, State Roads Commission.
