Ella Marshall (col.) reports that a baby, the child of Cora Gunn, Dameron, P.O.Md., died, and that there are no funds for burial; husband is in hospital; Welfare Board reports that it has no jurisdiction. Commissioners authorized Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars for burial of baby.

Mr. Cheney, States Roads Commission, appeared before the Board and stated that Prison Labor will not be available for farmers because they cannot be released for farm work without hurt to the road work, for which their quarters were erected at a cost of \$15,000.00 to the State Roads Commission.

Mr. J. Julius Johnson, County Agent, came before the Board and the matter of Farm Man Power was discussed. The Commissioners took no official action on the question.

Board reviewed the renovation work on the Court House.

Board set Thursday Nov. 9th, as the day on which to review and hear protests on assessments of property situate in First Election District and directed clerk to send out the 10 day noticez to all taxpayers affected.

On motion of Mr. Jarboe, Board approves that copies of the past five years audits be made available from Mr. E.E.Woolen, C.P.A., Balto., Md., Auditor, to Maryland Public Expenditure Council of Baltimore for analytical research, with the understanding that copies of the findings be supplied to the County Commissioners free of charge.
