Mr. Joe Cheney, Dist. Eng. State Roads Comm., Mr. Kenneth Webb, Asst. Dist. Eng. and Mr. Chapman Thompson, Res. Eng., appeared before the Board. Mr. Cheney read a letter from Chief Eng. Ballard concerning postwar Bridge and Road construction and main-These projects are to be financed by the Federal Government on the match basis and the amounts \$30,000.00 aproximately Federal Funds \$30,000.00 approximately County Funds. After consideration by the Board, on motion of Mr. Jarboe, seconded by Mr. Guy, it was decided that after maintenance of roads is taken care of, the Board would prefer that the balance of the $l_2^1 c$ gasoline tax be used toward building of a lower type road than would be exacted by hte Federal Government and the State Roads Commission. They further urge that the State Roads Commission avail themselves of the Federal money to be used for reconstructing arterial highways in St. Mary's County. That the County Commissioners, after being informed that their views are accepted by the State Roads Commission, will gladly stipulate the roads to be constructed; the lower type roads to be built by State Roads personnel and equipment.

Motion unanimously adopted.

Mr. Philip H. Dorsey appeared before the Board to ascertain a date which is convenient for the Board to discuss with representatives of the Postwar Planning Commission projects affecting St. Mary's County. The Board set Nov. 27 at 2 p.m. as a satisfactory date.

The Board ordered that the County agrees to pay \$19.50 per month for Lexington Park Vol. Fire Dept. alarm service.

The Board directed their clerk to request Mr. E.E.Woollen, CPA to loan Mr. John M. Hougardy of Baltimore, copies of the audits of the County Commissioners for the past five years.

The Board ordered their clerk to furnish to Mr. Tobin, editor of the St. Mary's News, a transcript of the awarded bids upon which school children are transported to schools not receiving State aid.
