Meeting held for the purpose of hearing protests on assessments in 9th District, in accordance with notices sent to property holders there. No protests were made. Assessments as recorded stand.

The Board heard from Mr. Alvin Pasarew, Director Maryland State Planning Commission, who urged that the Commissioners take the necessary steps toward securing that the provisions of Chap. #599, Acts of 1933 be made operative for the County, in order to set up a Zoning and Planning Authority. Mr. Pasarew was accompanied by Mr. Nicholet, U.S.N., (Civilian Corps). Quite a lengthy discussion was held. Present at this meeting were Messrs. J. Allen Cecil and J. Claude Johnson, representatives to the Legislature from Maryland, St. Mary's Count. The Board took no action at this time.

Commissioners locked over grounds and viewed the jail.

Board adjourned at 4 p.m.
