Motion by Mr. Jarboe:- Inasmuch as a large delegation of the Citizens of the Fifth District and representation of the Board of Education have urged the erection of a Consolidated Elementary School to be located in the vicinity of Mechanicsville, therefore it is proposed that the Commissioners allocate a sum equivalent to  $1/2$  or 50% of the amount necessary in payment of the architect's fee for the desired structure; said sum not to exceed \$3,000.00, and further, that Mr. James Baldwin be employed as the architect. Motion seconded by Mr. John Guy and motion was unanimously adopted.
