Minutes of previous meeting read and approved *Aug 12, 1945.*

Board decided to allocate a sum not to exceed \$150.00 to purchase dynamite for the improvement of Deep Creek, toward the eradication of mosquitoes. This work to be done under the supervision of the Department of Health.

The Zoning and Planning Commission was discussed and the following personnel were selected;

ELMER R. JARBOE, to be the County Commissioners' representative on the Commission; Messrs. PAUL BAILEY, ROY GUYTHER, STANLEY L. RALEY, M.C. THOMPSON, JR., to be members of the Saint Mary's County Zoning and Planning Commission; Chap. 808, Acts of 1945- see Chap. 599 Acts 1933.

The members of the Saint Mary's County Zoning Appeal Board to be Messrs. James Thomas, Wm. L. Calaway and G. Schley Miles.

Clerk was instructed to mail notices of appointment to each of above mentioned members of their respective positions.

Memo:- Mr. Nocilet was present at this meeting, at which it was decided to hold a meeting of the two Boards at the offices of the County Commissioners, Court House, Leonardtown, Md., on Friday, June 5th, 1945 at 7 o'clock p.m.

Note- notices were sent in conformity with above.

Upon the certificates of Drs. Eugene C. Peck and Frank A. Camalier Robert Bowman was committed to the Crownsville Hospital for Insane. Note- Miss Little communicated with re above, and she will remove patient from here to hospital on Saturday. In this connection Board instructed the clerk to request certified copies of the examination of the two Baltimore doctors, upon whose certificates Hilda Jordan was admitted to Crownsville.

Clerk was directed to write Federal Public Housing Authority requesting that the amount in lieu of taxes on the agreed basis \$894,894 @ \$1.40 be paid to the Commissioners. This, attention of Mr. Patterson. *Prescott*

A request from the Cooperative Extension Work for an increase in the salaries of the office force was read, together with a letter from E.I. Oswald, Assistant Director, recommending said increase. Board instructed the Clerk to write Dr. Symons, informing him that they will include the amount specified, that if \$300.00 in next year's budget, request having been received too late for action for the current levy of 1945, provided his office will take care of the increase for the current year.
