Right of Way, Grt. Mills

Vet. Club, represented by Mr. Rysticken, again requests Board
allow them to use old road closed when new State Rd. built.
Board advised that had signed a Quit Claim Deed on same. Mr.
Briscoe instructed to file a written opinion in this matter.

St. George Island

Mr. L. Henderson representing citizens of Island, desires to
know decision reached by Bd. on road building, and repair.
Mr. Thompson reports that with 12 consecutive days of good
weather he could complete repair work. Matter of constructing
new road held until spring '48. This road is #1 on priority
list. Recent high tides have washed away more road.

St. Geo. Isl. Bulkhead

Work of installing breakwater bulkhead now reached point where
backfilling is needed, last storm washed away 6 ft of land.
Road is now but 1 ft. from bulkhead. Clerk instructed to
write Mr. Chaney of SRC., requesting backfill be done by County
SR crew and charged to County maintenance. Mar. 3345.

Joe Weiner, atty for Jas. Robt. Long, appeared relative to damage
to truck on Coolie's Run Bridge. 2T truck, loaded with 8T
fertilizer crashed in bridge and badly damaged. Bridge examined
shows no bad timber, except in one place. Bridge not posted as to
tonnage. Claims \$344. Mr. Weiner instructed to prepare detailed
report in writing, etc. and present same. All bridges to be posted
as to weight capacity- Mr. Thompson so instructed.

Mr. Barnard Smith of Smith's Inc., displayed detailed blueprints,
and explained central heating system planned for Court House and
County buildings. ~~Not to exceed \$8,700. plus expense of boiler~~
room. RESOLUTION passed by Board "that Mr. Briscoe is to prepare
contract with Mr. B.I. Smith for installation of Central heating
plant for Court House and County Office Bldg, at and for a price not
to exceed \$8,700- plus expense of boiler room to be erected."
Mr. Smith is to consult with Mr. Briscoe as to standard form of
contract for his inspection etc.

Due to approaching winter weather, and inability to have road construction completed now Board passed the following resolution "All construction work on roads will be postponed until spring because of unfavorable working conditions." Only emergency and repair work to be done now.
