Be it resolved and Ordained, by the Commissioners of Leonardtown in legal meeting assembled, that all coin operated machines with revolving wheels or cylinders and commonly known as slot machines or console machines whether discharging coins or not, and all machines known as race horse machines and pin ball machines, whether discharging same or not, and all claw machines or similar devices (music boxes and bona fide vending machines excepted); operated within the corporate limits of the town of Leonardtown, St. Mary's County, Maryland, shall be subject to a gross receipt of $5\frac{1}{2}$ per cent to be collected by the Comptroller of the State of Maryland, under the providence of Chapter 748 of Article 56 of the Annotated code of Maryland as enacted by Chapter 601 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, Session 1947, the balance of said tax to be paid over to the Commissioners of Leonardtown by said Comptroller after the deductions of all legal charges and Commissions for collection; be it further resolved and ordained that this resolution and ordinance shall ~~both~~ affect as of this date.
