Petition presented by Mr. Paul Balto, signed by taxpayers requesting blacktopping for Matapani Road.

ST. GEORGE ISLAND

Mr. Lawrence Henderson presented a diagram showing location of road in need of repairs in a section not included in contemplated schedule. It was decided that any work done there will be in accordance with plans previously adopted.

COUNTY-WIDE SANITATION.

Meetings had previously been held between Dr. G.Waters, DHO.

St. Mary's County, Messrs. Gwynn of State Health Dept., Mr. Briscoe atty to the Board and Mr. King, clerk relative to sanitary conditions; water, sewage, hygiene of places serving food and drink to the public. At a former meeting Dr. French of Anna Arundel County was also present. Mr. Briscoe suggested that Dr. Waters have prepared a set of Health Regulations for consideration by the Commissioners at an early date. Vital Statistics Bureau estimates the population of the County to be 32,300. Present sanitation is inadequate.

CARVER HEIGHTS DORMITORY
A letter was addressed to the FPHA in NYC., with check enclosed for the purchase of Carver Heights Dormitory. Same to be remodelled into school for use of colored pupils in that area. It is anticipated purchase etc., will go through and work started on the building at an early date.

LOAN OF \$200,000.00 for SCHOOLS REQUESTED.

Messrs Robert Burroughs and Oliver Guyther of Mechanicsville appeared requesting that the Board reconsider it's decision with regard to borrowing the amount of \$200,000.00 for the Consolidated School in the 5th Election District. Capt. Matt Bailey and Mr. Frank Raley announced that in their opinion it would be wiser to wait until the coming election in November and see the results of the Referendum on the \$350,000.00, before taking any action in the above matter.

LOTS AT ALMS HOUSE
Mr. John M. Goldsborough made application to purchase a lot on
the Alms House Tract. Matter referred to Mr. Briscoe.
