4th Dist. Chaptico Public Landing  
West from Maddox 1 mi. to Chap. Pub. Lndg-Wicomico  
serves 13 families- delegation Messrs. Farr, Clarke, Yowaiski  
Advised secure Deed for Right of Way, and survey to be made  
before County can accept road for maintenance.

7th Dist. St. Patrick's Creek Road  
Mr. and Mrs. Frank Brown, Alice Brown, Mrs. Jno Mattingly  
Mrs. Fred Mattingly. Right of Way has been secured for all but  
1/2 mi. Serves 23 families, store and oyster house located on  
road, also used by School bus. In very bad condition. Neces-  
sary procedure explained. Matter referred to Mr. Thompson

8th Dist. 3 Notch Point Road  
1 1/2 mi to Bay- serves 12 families 1 mi below Hermanville,  
Mr. T. Paul Hayden and Mrs. Emma Hayden appeared and proper  
procedure explained. Road is not a County road. Matter referred  
to Mr. Thompson

8th Dist  
Delegation- Mrs. Geo. Steele- O.D. Barefoot, Paul Hicks, W.R.  
Stogie, H.M. Owens, Albert Haynes & Leroy Sonntag request  
road be changed in location 1/2 mi. 8 houses-2 farms on road.  
Building activities would be increased if road were improved.  
Several feeder roads lead here. Should be widened to 30 ft.  
Mr. Thompson suggests road be graded, levelled and accepted by  
County for maintenance. Delegation instructed as to necessary  
procedure. To present deed and survey.

Deed for Right of Way in Priscoe sub-division presentd and ac-  
cepted by County- SRC requested to include road in Maintenance  
list.

8th Dist Howe's Road- private road.  
Mr. Thompson will make report on this road later.

Bd. Education reports check for \$3,500 for payment of Carver Hts  
dormitory is at bank.
