

AUGUST 31, 1948

SPECIAL MEETING

The Board met at ten am., all members present.

The first matter considered was the transportation of school children to Little Flower, Great Mills and St. Michael's, Ridge from the N.A.T.C. base and Lexington Park area by the Navy. Comm. Neilson, UENATC., Lieut. Pimlot, JSNATC, Ens. Slason, USN NATC, also Rev. Downing, SJ and Rev. Heney, SJ, present, representing Little Flower and St. Michael's Schools, respectively. All details as to routes, etc., not completed but understanding reached that Navy buses will transport children, residing on the Reservation.

Discussion of procedure of Electrical Board as regards handling applications, examinations, etc., for qualifying as Master Electrician under the regulations of the Electrical Board, and method of informing applicants as to applications, results of examinations etc. All communications on the subject are to be by "registered mail, return receipt requested."

Question of re-zoning as "Commercial" from "A" residential, an area along the Three Notch Road in the vicinity of the Catholic Church (colored) adjacent to Mr. A.F.B. Briscoe's property, was held over for additional data on same. Report filed by Secretary of Planning Board received.

Parking at Park Theatre discussed. Additional data on subject desired pending action by Mr. Briscoe to take up the matter with proprietors when information is ascertained.

Mr. James Waring, representing Greenwell Co., authorized to increase insurance on Court house to \$60,000.00 and on County Office Building to \$15,000, and also to effect extended coverage.

Clerk authorized to write State Roads Commission re two graders they desire to purchase for use by the County from the \$15,000 recently paid them for use of the County roads. Mr. Thompson to supply further information relative to the graders etc.
