District Forester desires use of Court Room Feb 3, per-  
mission given by phone, letter requested from them for files.

Delegation from St. Geo. Island re road on late Dr. Barber  
property. 10 families have no access to property except by *use of*  
private road, desire State Road 1/4 mi. Mr. Thompson was  
instructed to view the desired road bed and make recommendations.  
If DEED can be secured from all parties for R of W, road will  
be accepted into system for maintenance.

Dr. Riley, from State Bd. of Health, Balto., with Dr. Collinson  
Mr. Gwynn, Mr. Hobler and Mr. Stahl appeared relative to  
county health conditions. Dr. Riley recommends they get along  
with Dr. Collinson as part-time officer until other plans can be  
made. Also requests County augment allotment by \$1200.00.

Dr. R. feels the County needs an inspector with knowledge of plumbing, in addition to present inspector of sanitation. Also feels Board and Health Dept should get together and prepare budget and program for work. Also, that while authority is available, he prefers persuasion be used in matters of law enforcement. Dr. Collinson desires plan Medical Care Committee, with one member of Bd a committee. Dr. Riley advises County staff costs State \$39,463.25 per annum, feels County should contribute more, at present County pays \$1000.00 towards Health Nurse and \$600 on salary of Inspector. Dr. R. feels the County should pay at least \$1200.00 per annum additional now. When full-time health officer is available he will request County to augment that with good sum towards his salary Plan was for technician to work at LaPlata hospital and also at St. Mary's Hospital doing laboratory work. ok at LaPlata, but not at St. Mary's. Health Officer salary is regulated by law, min \$5500 max. 6300; all state officers are on part time -6 mo- probation
