Board met at 10 a.m. all members present. Clerk and assistant ill. F X King took notes.

Alms House report- Messrs Bailey and Duke unable to enter building due to scarlet fever of inmates. Report postponed.

R.B.Broun, Jr., chairman of Advisory Board presented recommendations of Advisory Board relative to School Building Program. Mrs. Dan Danvis in accord with all except site for school filed Minority report- she approves site already purchased for that purpose. Mr. Broun also read a letter from a bonding company relative to matter of selling bonds etc. For consideration when plans are completed.

Mr. John R. Drury, pres. Bd Directors St. Mary's Hospital called for and received check for \$1300.00 emergency revenue for Hospital. It appears that in years past the Welfare Bd sent indigent patients to hospital and county assumed responsibility for them, if Welfare Bd furnished copy of certificate of hospitalization. However, in this instance Welf. Bd had failed to furnish certificate and so County could not pay. This \$1300 was granted by act of Gen Assembly 1948, to assist in paying for indigent patients. Hereafter, County will pay up to \$1300 per annum if proper certificates are furnished. Mr. Briscoe will take matter up with county delegates to change the law. (1948)

Deeds of Dedication for roads in Lexington Park presented by Mr. Nicolet of Planning Bd- deeds recorded.

Mr. Chas. Fenwick submitted new law for Fire Dept. Bd will ask members of legislature to make law in conformity with request of Mr. Fenwick. Bd. approved.

Letter recd. from FWA re purchase of GHMS for \$39.500 will take this up after court when Mr. Briscoe is at leisure.
