Lieut. C omm. J.T. Downs, USNATC appeared relative to SEA Wall
at Tall Timbers says citizens are willing to pay Erosion Tax
if County will erect sea wall or take precaution to save
property. Letter addressed to all 3 representatives in Leg-
islature, delivered in person by Mr. Thompson, Jr., dictated
by JHTB/ as follows

"It is requested that if it is possible to do so,
you have introduced and passed legislation which
would enable the creation of an Erosion District
and imposition of Special Erosion Tax, with spe-
cial reference to the Tall Timbers area. It is
also desirable, we think, that if authority were
given the County Commissioners to set up a special
Erosion District and impos~~e~~ special erosion tax

in other sections of the County. As we consider this an Emergency Measure we would appreciate any effort that can be made to put this through at this session. We might add that it is our understanding that the persons in the Tall Timbers area/would be /who affected by the imposition of this tax, are agreeable to the imposition of same, and are willing to assume their portion in connection therewith."

Petitions received from citizens in neighborhood of CornField Harbor, against erection of Colored Boys Club there by D.C.Policemen. No action taken. Not properly zoned to prevent erection of club. Too late now to zone for that purpose.

Jos. Weiner, re J.M.Shaffer, Colton's Pt. purchased property at Tax Sale for \$450.00 - sold in Dec 1947 for 46 taxes- Metgas sold property- in 1927 it was reclaimed by Nat. Slav Society for default of mortgage Pembroke and Gasporovic bought same in 1941

Letter from Health Dept. requested Bd appoint member for Bd of Visitors for Md. State Chronic Hospitals, Mr. Frank Raley appointed on Bd and Dr. Riley so advised by letter.

Afternoon session given to considering Recommendations of Advisory Bd and Planning Commission re School Bldg program. Decided to await action of Legislature relative to pending bills.
