**NOTICE TO OWNERS OF COIN OPERATED MACHINES**

**ANNUAL LICENSES** for all Coin Operated Machines in St. Mary's County, Md., **MUST BE RENEWED ON OR BEFORE MAY 31, annually.**

All Renewal Licenses issued after that date will carry a **Penalty** of Ten Percent (10%) per month. Full License Fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) will be charged for all New Machines Licensed after May 1, of each year.

All old machine license plates must be removed from Coin operated machines and must be returned to the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of St. Mary's Co., Md., by June 1, 1949
