SPECIAL MEETING WITH MR. JUMP

The Board of Commissioners met at one p.m., with Mr. A.S. Jump who went into the matter of the Tax Bills etc., in detail. Chas. J. Mattingly, Treas was also present.

He advises that many errors have been made in figuring the tax bills for 1950. Mr. Jump says this work should be double checked to prevent errors.

Mr. Mattingly approves the installation of a Tax Billing machine. Machine will eliminate errors, etc and pay for itself in a few years. He says growth of the County has increased the work of the Treasurer's office and at present the office is undermanned.

It will require 4-5 months to build the machine, require 3-4 weeks to instruct the operator who would then be in a position to prepare accurate bills for 1951. Machine will cost \$2200.00 and \$500 for paper; be serviced 1 year free with check up following every 3-4 months.

Mr. Frank Bailey agrees with Mr. Jump the machine is necessary and will benefit the County. Capt Matt R. Bailey and J. Frank Raley want to think it over.

Meeting adjourned at 3 p.m. No action taken.
