Health Dept. Request

Dr. Harris requested that hereafter \$1,000 annual allotment for nurse be changed to \$760 for nurse and \$240 for clerical assistance, and check for \$20 be mailed monthly to clerk in local health dept. Bd. agreed. Effective Jan 1-51 since Bd. has already sent \$1,000 to State Bd. of Health for 1950

Fiscal Year Change

Chap. 47, Local Code Sec 50-Art 19 SB 136 page 317-318 permits County Commissioners to change the fiscal year of this County from Jan 1 to Dec 31, to July 1 to June 30- this will remove duplication of budgets since most of the County offices operate July 1 to June 30. This change will become effective Jan 1, 1951

Change of Room in Court House

Petit Jury room to be divided, lavatory installed and room furnished for use of Judge; other part of Petit Jury room to be used as Law Library; present Judge's room to be used by Petit Jury, present Law Library to be used by Supvs. of Election and Planning Commission. Bids to be requested for carpenter work in Petit Jury room. Bid accepted from SMITH'S INC for lavatory \$275.00.

Bob Hendrix, Lexington Park appointed Special Dog Deputy law pertaining to tagging of all dogs to be enforced- all

untagged dogs to be destroyed- all dog owners refusing to purchase tags for 1950 will be prosecuted.

Mr. Herbert Schmidt, Fed. Housing Admin. letter to be sent advising that when Deed for R of W has been received for Old Willows from the FHA and Navy, County will make the necessary improvements in the road.

Ball Park Project- Barnard Smith and Chapman Thompson presented an agreement signed by Nace Ford present Supt of Alms House, releasing 4 acres of land adjacent to the corner of land owned by Wm. Wise heirs on north field of Alms House property, and land to be used for Ball Park. Commissioners agreed to lease land to Ball Athletic Club for 25 years at \$100 per year. Nace Ford was paid \$100 (rent) by the Athletic Club, 1951 and thereafter to be pd to Co.Com.

JHT Briscoe, representing the Board met with the Town Commissioners relative to purchasing the incinerator at Baltimore of the Crown Cork and Seal Co for the sum of \$2,000. on the condition that for this amount the Co will dismantle, haul, install and teach an operator how to manipulate the incinerator, the price also to include a generator. Mr. Briscoe will write the letter.
