

July 25, 1950

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session today with all members present.

#### Roads.

##### Camp Dengees

Road used by summer campers as well as 8 permanent families approved for widening at narrow end.

Roadway into the farm owned by Mrs. Alfonsus Guy and Mrs. Richd. Downs closed some years ago- approved for opening if Mrs. Guy secures permission from Mr. L. Vallandingham to straighten run.

#### Erosion

Erosion at Tall Timbers- Lt. Com. Jas. Downs appeared asking the Board to consider relief afforded by law passed in 1950.

Com. Downs desired Board's reply as to whether or not they would follow the law- Board requested Com. Downs to ascertain if 75% of the property owners desired this relief in view of the extra taxes etc., required. Lt. Downs will advise Board of the results of a meeting of the T.T. property owners on Aug 25 when they expect to be able to lay plans, prices for jetties etc., before the Board. Mr. Briscoe to study the law and further advise the T.T. property owners as to their share in the extra taxes etc. Mr. Briscoe suggested that T T property owners go to Annapolis and consult with the County Commissioners there relative to the matter of erosion in that County etc.

#### Scotland Beach Sale of Taxsold property

Property secured by County through Tax Sale in 1931 sold to Mrs. L.M.Heagy and Mrs. A.C.McKenney of Wash.S.C. Land has State Road running through it, part of the unused land adjoins Mrs. McKenney's & Mrs. Heagey's lot on one side and property owned by Mr. Stafford on the other side. Lot sold to Mrs. H and Mrs. McK. for \$50. Mr. Briscoe will prepare the DEED. (This is the same land for which Mr. Arthur Eddy offered \$10.00 last spring before the County Commissioners considered selling. Property was sold to the present owners because it adjoined their land.) *Peter L. Eckert prop acquired by County 1931*

#### Reduction in Taxes.

Foley Drury appeared and requested reduction in taxes which had been increased a large amount over last bill. Mr. Briscoe advised that it would be practical to allow a reduction and Mr. Lawrence - absent today- will be told of the reduction.

#### Board of Education

Bd. of Education requested the Board of Commissioners to endorse application for use of funds received thru State School Aid to apply on balance due on purchase of Leonardtown School site. This was done.

Colored County Agent

Ryland Holmes, Carver Hts. Lexington Pk., Md., new County Agent for the Colored, who began his duties as of July 1, 1950 appeared and briefly outlined his plans for the coming year. Agent Holmes has an office in his home at Carver Hts thus relieving the County of rent etc. His salary as agreed upon between the Dept. of Agri and the Bd. is to be \$1,000 per year, payable \$83.33 monthly.
