

October 24, 1950

The Board of County Commissioners met today, all members present.

The first work was o'king vouchers for October expenses.

Roads.

Mrs. Gladstone, and sister, who own a portion of the Old Willow Glenn farm, Maddox, near Dr. Jacob's farm, requested the Board accept a road .045 miles which serves two families and 2 tenant families. In 1936 Mr. H.H. Bowling, Rd. Engineer, had culverts installed and dug a ditch, water then drained off the hill onto the farms. The County maintained this road for several years then ceased all repairs, etc. Capt. Bailet intimated he would go with Mr. Thompson to see the farms and road and report on the matter later. Mrs. Gladstone is erecting a home and asks that road be repaired in order that materials etc., may be brought in.

Jos. J. Johnson purchased land at a Tax Sale in 1930, same land was resold for taxes in 1932 but still unclaimed. Johnson now purchased the land from the Board for the sum of \$36.00 which covered taxes, interest and costs to date. Receipt was given him for the \$36.00 cash. Mr. Briscoe will prepare his deed

Mr. Amos Dean, opposite Mr. Pembroke Moore's wants road repaired, needs tarred apron or pipe whichever SRC will install. Mr. Thompson is to see road and report on same.

Letter from State Law Department re payment of GREAT MILLS HIGH SCHOOL- \$35,390.00 (money borrowed from 2 county banks for this purpose and Bd. desires repay bank loans) This amount can be secured from the State School Loan of 1949. Request was accordingly made thru the State Dept. of Education for the amount. The Commissioners also, at this time, advised that they intended to borrow the fullest amount allowable for Public School Construction.

Dr. Alan D. Houser, State Deputy Health Officer requested the Bd. to consider new site and quarters for County Health Dept. He feels the building should be located in or near Leonardtown, and asked the Bd. to appoint a Board of Fact Finding re necessity of such a move. Commissioners appointed Fr. Frank A. Camalier,

Mr. W. Haverman Mattingly Sr., Mr. Zach Fowler and Mrs. A.F. King to confer on the matter. Letters were addressed to each member requesting them to meet with Dr. Camalier when and where he suggests to study the matter and report to the Comm. copy of which report will be forwarded to the State Bd. of Health, Balto. Md. Dr. Houser advised the State of Md. will pay 44% of entire costs of site and building. This County is at present at the top of the Priority List and unless steps are taken to make use of this before Dec 31, the County will take the lowest place on the Priority list. Dr. Houser will be ex-officio of the Health Commission at all times. The Recommendations are to be made and approved this Bd. then passed on for completion to the new Bd. taking office in Dec. 1950

Bd. signed request for additional funds to be used by the Bd. of Education from the State Sch. Construction Loan.

Horse Landing Road.

Bridge in need of repairs. Mr. Thompson will study the DEED and if County owns land at the bridge, same will be repaired, otherwise it is not the County's responsibility.

Mr. M.C. Thompson and Mr. Tell W. Nicolet attended the Civil Defense meeting in Wash. Oct 17. this meeting not to be made public, funds will be required for County Civil Defense program, up to \$1,000.00. Bd. approved this to be included in Budget.

Road in Sotterly, new subdivision to be inspected by Mr. Thompson and if same meets with approval of SRC will be accepted, otherwise altho DEED for road R of W has been given to the County no action will be taken, until road meets full requirements of FHA

Mr. Frank Bailey reports the Bayside Road is in need of repair and is used by school buses, recently a collision between 2 buses was narrowly averted. Mr. Thompson was requested to look into the matter of necessary repairs which he agreed to do.
