was low bidder completed project \$74,400.00

M.M. Dean of Hollywood, (no backfill) \$86,206.00 rejected

L.A. Mattingly & Son, Leonardtown, Md backfill only
\$1.25 per cu yd- rejected.

Check for \$500.00 which accompanied Mr. Dean's bid was endorsed to County Treasurer for Deposit only and check for \$500 on CGF#1 was sent to Mr. Dean.

Check for \$500.00 which accompanied Mr. MacDonald's bid was deposited in Tall Timbers Erosion Relief Project account in 1st Nat. Bank, Leonardtown, Md.

Mr. MacDonald received a letter of bid-acceptance and was requested to start work as soon as possible-on or before Sept 1 and allowed 120 working days to complete the project. (Copy in file on this matter)

August 28 the Board will sign formal contract with Mr. MacDonald for the above project. In the meantime he has agreed to order materials etc., and plans to commence work at once.

Patuxent Beach -Zoning petition
Petition signed by 34 taxpayers of this area requested Zoning, 88 houses in this section. Deed for R of W was presented but Mr. Sterling advised it was incomplete and informed what was necessary. There will have to be a separate Deed from Mr. Blackstone and Mr. Wilkinson. Sub-division is from 3 Notch Rd, California to the Patuxent Road should be 30 ft wide. Mr. Thompson was present. Petition sent to the Planning Commission for their consideration and they to report to the Bd. and to Mr. Vance what they consider should be done. Mrs. Cissel of Silver Springs was in group; she has appeared before other Bds and asked for road.zoning etc.

Mr. Hubert Graves, Mech- Mr. Guy dictated letter to advise him that road had been considered and same will cost too much to widen

Mr. Nicolet was requested to prepare Notice of Public Hearing on rezoning for the 1,000 unit housing project- from "B residential to C residential. in paper of July 27-51

Mr. Lawrence requested date when Bd will sit in Tax Review- 2 days not on Regular meeting time. 5 & 6 Districts to be heard. No date set

Bd of Education appeared with group of teachers and representatives of PTAs, to ask that Bd send a representative to attend the sub-committee hearing on Teachers Salaries. Sen. Louis L. Goldtein of Calvert Co was chairman of group and Sen. Robt. Kimble of Allegany County and Del. Luber of Baltimore City members. A lengthy discussion was held by all present and it was decided Mr. Alvey would go to Annapolis on Wednesday July 25, and represent the Co. Com and made a short address. Mr. Sterling prepared the address, copy of which is on file and copy of which was sent to So. Md. Times, Annapolis, Beacon and Enterprise for use if desired.

Board adjourned at 5:50 with several matters left for the next regular meeting on Aug. 28/
