Regular Session

The County Commissioners met today in regular session with all members and their attorney present.

Resignation was received from trip Gen. Hume Peabody as Director of Civil Defense for St. Mary's, due to ill health. Letter was sent to Gen. Peabody advising him appointment would be made as soon as possible. He will serve until appointment is made.

Resignation received from Mr. J. Clarence Taylor, Justice of the Peace-due to ill health. Letter advising him of regret of County Commissioners, was sent.

Otis Jones, Del Rio Restaurant, Charlotte Hall, mistook his notice of Assessment for new tax bill and sent check. Letter of explanation was sent him and check enclosed.

Laura Brown, Bushwood, requests transportation for 2 children to St. Joseph's School. Nobel Beachum has this route and was advised to pick uo the children. This is $2\frac{1}{2}$ mi each way- 10 mi per day added to his contract \$360.00 per year, 36.00 per mo

Check in amount of \$4651.09 was drawn on CGF#3, County Trust Co Mech., Md., and deposited to BUILDING FUND, Co. T. Co. Mech.

Miss Eloise Pickrell, County librarian, presented report for 1st year at library. Asked for $\frac{1}{2}$ 1951-52 Budget. Same was sent.

Mr. Sterling told the Commissioners the suit should be tried and let the Court determine whether or not the law is constitutional.
