

March 11, 1952

Mr. Ohm of St. Clements Sh res called when the Commissioners and their attorney, met today about conditions of the septic tanks in St. Clements Shores. He had previously written to the Gov who referred the matter to the Comms. Mr. Ohm was referred to Mr. Jack Bell, sanitarian of the Health Dept and an appointment made for him to see Mr. Bell at once.

Mrs. Stuart Edmonds called about the Comms having a clinic to prevent dogs from getting rabies from foxes. This condition is prevalent in Pena and many people and animals are being bitten by mad foxes. Mr. Cosenien was present at this time and a lengthy discussion was held on the matter. The Comms considered publishing the law concerning tagging of dogs. No action taken. Mrs. Edmonds advised the Game Warden that she is willing to have deer placed on the church swamp but not on Lead-O-Bay farm. She was advised that no matter where you put the deer they will seek a place to live for themselves.

Mr. Greenwell called again about the Adams House property. At this time there was present a timber man who said he would buy the standing timber at 15 for oak and 20 for gum. The Comms. feel the timber on the land is worth more than the land and when they have a price they will advise Mr. Greenwell what it is worth and how much the land is worth.

Mr. Tilp asked about having a tree at the corner of the new health Center removed, at least part of it that rests against the building. He was given permission to have Mr. Sutter remove one side of the tree. The commissioners asked him if a 12 room school, where water and sewage would not be a cost- could be built for \$210,000.00 and he replied that M.M. Dean of Hollywood is now building a 10 room school with well and septic tank at Charles County, Va. for \$188,000.00 and he felt positive that a 12 room school could be built here for \$210,000.00. When the Board advised Miss Dent of this she said please write the Bd. of Education to that effect and she was certain they would agree to allocate \$158,000. State School Loan

and that would leave \$67,000 to be secured elsewhere Then the Bd. thought of the extra \$9,515.56 coming to the Bd. of Educa in June and decided to ask for that as well, making a total of \$192,515.56 for the Bd of Educa to pledge towards the new public school in Leonardtown.

The Comms. decided to ask the Town Comms. if they would supply pipes for water and sewage from the road to the school building and build an entrance on Route 5 to the new school building. Letter was written.
