Mr. Geo. Dederer called about Navy children being transported to Little Flower. This matter was taken up last fall and same decision rendered again this time. Navy will write asking Co. Com assume this transportation, Board will reply there are no funds for additional transportation at this time, should such funds become available (Pub. Law 874) the County will be in a position to set up the requested transportation for the children residing on the NATC Base.

Mrs. Boyd advised that the Baptist Church Rd, since the last rains is too narrow for 2 buses to pass.

Mr. Cecil Gibson asked about the road in the 7th-Gibson-Beitzell Road.
