A special meeting was held this afternoon between the County Commissioners, the Board of Education of St. Mary's County, Md., representatives of the Town Commissioners of Leonardtown, Mr. Johannes, architect and members of the Leonardtown PTA, in conjunction with the low bidder of the Leonardtown Public School Project, Mr. Roland B. Duke.

The lowest bid for the school was 64,000.00 above the amount set by the County Commissioners. It was suggested that the bw bidder and the architect meet to negotiate the matter of reducing the cost of the school. The County Commissioners requested permission to sit in on the negotiations and Mr. J. Claude Johnson, president of the Board of Education assured them of a welcome at each such meeting. The Board of Education also allocated an additional \$20,000.00 towards the project making their allocation
