Clarke's Landing to Yankee Pt. thru Norris and Lewis property will be accepted when DEED is prepared etc. At this time the road will be maintained only, not reconstructed.

Cornfield Harbor Road, Mr. Brickley asked for return of DEED and plat for Right of Way, as the owners decided to maintain road themselves.

Wharf, St. Catherine's Sound, White Neck
Letter to U S Army Engineers advising them the County had purchased this wharf for public use. 4 copies of drawing of wharf accompanied letter.

Folkener Photo Service bill was paid for Civil Defense Equipment They were requested to furnish Commissioners with 5 copies of receipted bill in order that County may be reimbursed.

Seal for Orphans' Court will cost \$90. Clerk was authorized to purchase same.
