

June 9, 1953

Regular meeting was held today with all members and their attorney present.

Hospital Committee composed of Dr. Roy Guyther and Messrs E.J. Waring and Jack Ruge called about a resident physician for St. Mary's Hospital whose salary is to be paid by the County Commissioners. They were informed that the Budget for 1953-4 carried a sum of \$5,000 as a gift for the new hospital wing. When asked which would be more preferred the money or the salary of a resident physician they could not reply until they talked to the Hospital Board. A resident physician would cost \$6,000 per year. A Dr. Geronimo, Philipino, whose wife is the anæsthetician at the hospital has been approached by the Committee and he would be willing to accept the position and he would be very agreeable to the hospital staff as they have worked with him for some time. However, the Bldg Committee has collected \$18,000 and it is necessary to collect an additional \$20,000 to meet the Federal Government requirements and the Hospital Committee will advise the Commissioners at a later date of their decision. The money for either the gift or salary will be available after July 1, 1953.

Street Lights, Great Mills Road. John K. Fogarty Post American Legion, represented by Messrs. Michael Keehan and Ralph Stanton called to ask the Commissioners to pay for the lights along the G.M. Road from Millionson's Bldg down towards the Spinning Wheel. Originally merchants paid for this, and recently the Post has paid for it but it is a great drain on their financial state. The Board advised that effective July 1 1953 they would assume responsibility for these lights. A letter was written to the So. Md. Elec. Co-Op Inc advising them of this decision, also a copy was sent to the Post.

Sanitarian. Dr. Houser and the Commissioners talked about the salary and expense account of Virgil H. Mast, <sup>appointed Jan 53.</sup> sanitarian. Hitherto Mr. Mast has received \$600 a year for the expenses but the State Dept of Health is now furnishing him a car and will maintain it, so his salary is to be that of all sanitarians in his class- effective July 1, 1953 he will receive \$3131.00 per annum with annual increase of \$125 until his salary reaches \$3700. Check to be made out on the 1st and 15th of each month, less wht. For 1953 to June 1954 the check will be \$130.45

Postals were sent out to all bus contractors advising them to be present June 23, 10 a.m. to renew contracts if they were satisfied with their present one. If not, they are to be advertised. Letter from Fr. Johnson advised that the contract and service of L.V. Dorsey for colored children to St. Joseph's church was ok.

Coin Op. Machines-unlicensed several on sidewalks in the old Shopping Center at the Park, 5 in front of the Variety Store 1 in front of the Drug Store. Mr. Nicolet advised that the weight machines had been placed there 3 years ago with the understanding they would be opened and split 50-50 with the store operators- this has never been done. The other machines P.T.17- X 17, Dopey Duck and Champion Space Ship belong to the Chris Novelty Co of Baltimore. None of the machines are licensed and they are in the way on the sidewalk. Citizens are complaining about them. W.M. Loker, Jr., asked if they should be licensed and there is no provision in the Resolution for such machines. *Letter to Chris Novelty Co informing if machines are not removed within 60 days, they will be confiscated.*

Trailer Law W.M. Loker, Jr., representing owners of trailers said in his opinion the law is unconstitutional as it refers to trailers. He cited the case of Anne Arundel County 1943 A.A.Co. vs English 182 Md. page 514 where the tax is referred to as a Use Tax on the trailer. A lengthy discussion followed and it was decided to let the Court have a Test case. The Commissioners feel that if this law is illegal, they will have one passed that will be legal.
