

February 23, 1954

The Board and their attorney met in regular session today.

Bauer Road- clerk was requested to write and inform Mr. Sam Bauer, St. Mary's City, 1st Elec. Dist that the Bauer road would receive oil treatment during the 1954 program.

Shrf. Long reported vandalism at GMHS and requested permission to employ watchmen in attempt to apprehend those responsible for breaking into and stealing goods from the supply room. Clerk instructed to advise Shrf, Long he could employ someone for 10 days, not to exceed \$10 per day, if possible.

Mr. Alfred Toombs, representing the County PTA asked the Commissioners to endorse passage of SB #18, which deals with increasing salary of School Supts Miss Dent whose salary is \$6,500 is lowest paid Supt in State, Bill would increase her salary to \$8,500. Miss Dent also appeared relative to this matter Phone calls were made to Delegate Duke and Sen Bailey, resulted in information Bill had passed the House and would come before the Senate that evening. St. Mary's representatives were requested to vote for same.

Tom Bond reported dog belonging to Mr. Smith on farm adjoining that of Mrs. Bond Sr was killing sheep-several persons saw the dog attack the sheep-Valley Greenwell and Mrs Julia Liston and others- Sheriff can go and take care of dog or Tom Bond can kill the dog- the latter went to talk with Mr. Smith's son who lives in Leonardtown. No action by Board.

Capps-Subdivision-Towne Creek- Mr. Nicolet made survey of this property owned by Mr. Capps and advises he Capps- has sold all of his lots; Mr. Capps stated he intends deeding all of his roads to County Commissioners- Comms have advised him several times roads will have to meet SRC specifications before they can be accepted for maintenance.

Hollywood Shores- new subdivision-Health Dept approves this if artesian wells supply water Owner must put up bond for \$10,500.00

Rezoning application and fee- Resolution was proposed by Mr. Alvey and approved by Comms. Guy and Stone- Resolved that all applications for rezoning of property must be accompanied by funds sufficient to meet all expenses incurred, ie advertising etc, a flat fee of \$50.00 with application.

Lawrence Hayden- on old St John Road- 4 families use road- asks that road be repaired- no action.

Board agreed to go along with Mr. Thompson on his request for more road equipment and clerk was authorized to give Mr. Thompson a letter to secure the necessary equipment. He is to get bids on same.

Mr. Wm; L. Calloway, member of the Zoning Board of Appeals resigned due to ill health, effective Feb 24, 1954

In the matter of the \$50 application rezoning fee- if the Notices are advertised and hearing held there is no refund, whether the request is approved or rejected.
