Board met in session today, all members and their attorney present.

#### Towne Creek Manor Speed Law

A delegation of the Towne Creek Citizens' Association, LCDR J.H. Henderson, spokesman, with Messrs Duquette and Merchant appeared to ask that speed signs be placed in that area cutting down the speed. After conferring with Mr. Thompson the Board decided they would have erected signs setting the speed

Towne Creek Manor Road	30 MPH
Sunrise Drive	30 MPH

This is the minimum speed the State allows for residential sections. The following Resolution was introduced by Mr. Alvey, seconded and approved by Messrs Guy and Stone:-

RESOLVED: that the speed limits in Towne Creek Manor, California, Md., on Towne Creek Road and Sunrise Drive be maintained at 30 MPH, and the State Police notified of this and asked to enforce the law and maintain this speed." 34 families live along this area and many small children play there. LCDR Henderson was advised by letter of the action taken.

#### Zoning

The Citizens' Association of Towne Creek Manor presented maps prepared showing where they would like the area zoned. Letter was sent to them advising the request would be placed before the Planning and Zoning Commission who would consult with the Association later.

#### Conference.

Dr. Houser asked that funds be allocated for the use of Sanitarian Virgil H. Mast to attend a conference in North Carolina, a Training Course approved by the State Health Dept. Request was granted.

Noble Beachum asked permission to transfer his parochial school bus route to Alice Marshall, driver J. Somerville. Board will advise him of their decision as he does not want the route advertised.

Board invited to attend the public dedication of Leonardtown Public School March 11, 8 p.m.

J. Ralph Abell, Sr., Supervisor of Assessments suffered a leg injury when he fell. He will be incapacitated for some time. During his illness Mr. Herbert has been instructed to secure an assistant, and Mr. Herbert will be paid 7¢ per mile for travel. The pay for assistant will be \$7 per day. Mr. Abell is to receive his salary but not expense account.

Wm. Callaway resigned from the Appeals Board of the Zoning Commission, due to illness. Mr. Irving Hewett was asked to serve in Mr. Callaway's place.

Request for rates of insurance on funds kept in the Treasurer's office. R.B.Broun, Jr., J.R. Drury & Son, J.T. Waring & Son sent letters asking for rates on \$3,000 full year \$7,000 additional Mar 15-April 15, annually.

Complaint that Scanlon Herbert was discharging children at the intersection of the roads at Morganza, Md., was heard and Board instructed clerk to advise Scanlon children must be carried direct to the school before being let off the bus.
