Mrs. L.J.Hartin, Hermanville, asks bus to come up 1½ mi to meet small child who has to walk thru heavy traffic- Mr. Stone to see about this GM-2713 Woodburn's bus

Anna Mae Carry- WOBennett's bus to come 1½ mi for 2 children No. Lntn ok

Jos.A.Mattingly, advised to have his child board the bus which comes to CBGreenwell's (no extra mileage for Paul Bell's bus is needed for this.)

Mrs. Francis Stevens, Calif GM 6243 asks Alex Hebb's bus to come for child- bus now goes past Dr. Patrick's- no extra mileage needed for this.

Leroy Thompson, advised to take all children who were on the road and if overcrowded to advise Board at next meeting. Maybe necessary to put on extra bus for this.

Mr. deJaeger called about donation for St. Mary's Hospital drive- was informed Board had made pledge of \$10,000 for 1954-55 and was also paying \$6,000 for resident physician.

Clerk was instructed to have Welfare make financial investigation of Irving Hewett since his son Preston I. Hewett was hospitalized and County paying for same.

Mrs. Miller- called about status of the Miller-VanWerd road and was advised DEED had been prepared and Board was waiting for Mr. VanWerd to sign same. Mrs. M. says she will pay for Deed and survey.

Dr. Robt. Locke-sanitarian called with Mr. Richard Barber of Charlotte Hall about the appointment of a Plumbing-Building inspector. Mr. Barber has been an inspector in Balto since 1904-now retired Dr. Locke was asked to ascertain salary paid in Balto for such work- no decision at this time.

Clements School

Miss Dent was asked to come in about Clements school-it was understood she was having the old school repaired etc., to be used by the Amish children- this she explained was due to congestion in schools and bus transportation since most of the pupils live very close to the school. It is possible the Bd. of Educa may put all Amish and Menonites in one group since other Counties are doing this. The Board of Commissioners feel they have gone to a great deal of expense etc., to secure money for new modern schools and if the A and M parents dont want their children to attend the modern schools the County will furnish transportation and the A & M parents must meet all other expenses.

Letter to Mr. Chappellear concerning the R of W to Breton Beach Mr. Thompson has been requested to inspect the requested R of W and make his recommendations at the next meeting-Aug 24, 1954 at which time the Co.Coms will advise Mr. Chappellear of his findings.
