JHT Briscoe presents "confirmatory" deed for Col. Lawrence Peake who purchased the VKCampbell property in the 1st Elec. Dist in 1948 but original deed stated he had purchased from late Treas JBDrury and referred to wrong Tax Sale- this is the same property sold in 1950 by the County

Mrs. J. Gibbons Guy requested contract renewed to transport children from the MacIntosh Road to parochial school bus-\$50 per month Sept to June-\$500.00 Board agreed

Mrs. Miller called about the Miller-VanWerd road in the 7th and was informed Mr. Thompson had just had DEED signed by Mr. Van Werd.

Oliver R. Guyther, representing the Hospital Building Committee explained in detail about the drive, requesting the Board to contribute the sum of \$10,000 per annum for the next four years which would bring the County pledge up to \$50,000.00. The Board signed a letter stating they would request the St. Mary's County Senator and delegates to introduce a Bill in the coming Md. Legislature which would authorize the Co.Coms to make such a contribution— with the understanding that they would discontinue the annual appropriation of \$6,000 for a resident physician. Mr. Guyther assured them the new hospital would be on an accepted base, similar to city hospitals, where newly graduated physicians could interne and we would then no longer need a res. phys.

Aug 10 a letter addressed to Dr. J.Bay Jacobs re-R of W thru his property has never been answered. Clerk was requested to write and ask Dr. Jacob's to reply to the first letter.



re: Appropriations to St. Mary's Hospital Building Fund

This will advise that the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County, Md., will request the State Senator and Delegates for St. Mary's County, Md., to introduce at the coming session of the Maryland Legislature, a Bill which would authorize the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County, Md., in its discretion, to appropriate the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars per year, for a period of four years, for the Building Fund of St. Mary's Hospital, Inc.

Of course, it should be realized, however, that if such appropriations be authorized and made, the County Commissioners will discontinue the annual appropriation now made to the said hospital for the hire of a resident physician.

If the proposed Bill becomes enacted into law, and the annual appropriations made thereunder, the County Commissioners will then have contributed to the Building Fund of said hospital a total of Fifty Thousand Dollars.
