

January 4, 1955

Today was the first meeting of the year. All members and their attorney were present.

Extension of route requested by Mrs. Claude Jarboe, for Leo Bean to pick up and return Jarboe children. Father has been carrying them to school and they have returned on the bus. This would make 2 daily trips for the bus. Mr. Stone will contact Leo Bean and see if time doing this is too long, and bus would have to start earlier.

Extension at Rosebank for Jimmy Haden's 2 children, Mrs. Green's son and another high school girl. 2.2½ mi each way, 5 mi per day \$1.00 - Paul Bell to be contacted and ascertain if he can make this run without changing time. Notify Mrs. Haden. (Bell was contacted and he could do it ok. Mrs. Haden was notified (children sick with whooping cough)

Duke Construction Co claim for repairs to Court House chimney etc. To be paid in full by County, and part reimbursed by Ins. Co.

F. Verand Cecil took oath of office as County Treas and presented bond for \$25,000 collector of County Taxes, \$15,000 for State taxes and \$5,000 for motor tags.

It was decided that all road complaints should be heard on the 1st and 3rd Tuesdays of each month. Mr. Thompson was advised of this.

Mrs. Feabody called about a Dog Pound and suggested using part of the Alms House property for this work. Bd. told her to go ahead and find out the cost of building the pound and a small structure for the Keeper to remain in, etc.

Site for Public Dump located at ^{Raymont} John Taylor's near Compton. Place belongs to Taylor heirs and the sum of \$50.00 was paid for use of the ground- this is not to be an annual payment.
