All members and their attorney attended today's meeting.

Miss Joy with Mrs. Adams, and other volunteer 4H workers appeared to urge the Commissioners to allow the sum of \$2,000 per year for an Ass't. Home Demonstration for work with the 4 H clubs. Decision must be made prior to July 1st or State funds will be allocated to other Counties which ask for them and meet the amount the State allocates. Group feels that 4H club work helps keep down Juvenile Delinquency. Several local leaders work with these 4H members and receive no pay. The \$2,000 requested represents part of salary and travel for a trainee worker-State pays the balance. Board feels it is a worthy project and will make decision later.

Mrs. Hupp of the Welfare Board brought over figures on County's share of this for 1955-56 and it is up \$11,000 more than the amount anticipated by them when the Budget was prepared. Board will advise them of their decision later.

Rev. Melvin Schmidt, pastor Lutheran Church, 83 Anderson Court, Lex. Pk to be advised by letter that large hole in road near church is matter of property owner and not the County or State. Letter was written.

Dr. Fisher, State Bd. Med. Examiners asked if Bd. felt the fee of examinations after death should be raised. They now are \$15.00 for each examination Dr. Lane performs. The County will no longer pay for autopsies. Bd. advised by letter they felt the fee should remain \$15.00 for the present.

J. Louis Mattingly, Coin Mach License Inspector was called in to ask about full inspection of these machines- Board is considering raising his salary in order that he may put more time on the job- he agreed he could for \$1200.00 per yr.

Sheriff called about uniforms for the Sheriff and deputies. Color etc., will be determined at next meeting.

Mr. Sterling to prepare Amendment to Resolution of 1947 regarding specified kind of machines to be taxed.

Mr. Dorsey, representing owners asked that County prepare road leading to the "Plains" 1 1/2 mi. County advised it could do nothing this year. He will come with Gen. Louis Goldstein next meeting to ascertain just exactly what can be done and when.
