certain area in 8th Elec Dist. 6,000 ft from main gate, to Cedar Park Trailer Camp
Lex. Pk, Center Gardens, Patuxent Park, Patuxent Motor Sales Co to beginning of
Carver Hts which is not included- to Spinning Wheel down GM road. Mr. Rysticken
says Navy has declared willingness to go along with the project he feels they may
consider selling houses in their area to private owners thus putting the property
back on the tax books again. Commissioners said they would like to consider the
amount of revenue it would remove from the County, and if it does not deplete the
