At the regular meeting held today all members and their attorney were present.

Boys' Club of Washington, D.C. Mr. Paul Cassasa, Ex. officer and Mr. Pratt attorney for the Club called about the property tax. Boys Club is a non-profitable organization, about 60% of the expenses being paid from the Community Chest of Wash DC., and the balance from private subscriptions. Estimated size of property was 110 acres, lost 10 acres in "Hazel". Entire property is used for boys- all vegetables and produce raised is used in the camp-nothing is sold. Decision of Atty Genl for Md. previously received was that the organization's property was non-taxable. County Commissioners agreed with this decision and Mr. J. Ralph Abell, Supvrs of Assmnts and Mr. W.F. Herbert, Tax Assessor, were present and advised of this.

Road at Compton- Mrs. Barbara W. Russell advised that FHA would not make loan on home unless County took over road. 4 families on road now- Henry Wathen, Mrs Anna Mae Wathen-2 tenants Ed and Sonny Price live on road now. Commissioners will view the land and decide at next meeting what they will do. - *refused*

Richard Thompson, St. Geo. Isl. asks that gravel be put on his road. Mr. Thompson not here, no decision made.

J.H. Spencer of the Spencer Apts, G.Mills asks that County install sewage for that area. This ties in with request from citizens along the G.M. road. No decision.

Mr. Lipski, CPA, County auditor, asked that letters be written to 1st Nat Bank -to hold intact account of late Trial Mag. W.H. Knight, Co. Tr. Co- same for account of former Sheriff Willard B. Long, this to be done in order that audit may be completed, and only drafts to be honored are those presented by the County Commissioners on either account.
